

# PRIZED WRITING 2009-2010

Entries not conforming to the rules as specified here may be disqualified.

## Contest Rules

- Contestants must be undergraduates whose work was written for a UC Davis course during the 2009-2010 academic year beginning with Summer Session I, 2009.
- Entries must be the original work of the contestant.
- Authors will be responsible for the accuracy of their work, their quotations, and their documentation; they will also be responsible for securing copyright permissions for any borrowed graphics and photographs.
- All winning entries will be copyedited, and authors may be asked to revise their pieces for publication.
- Winning entries will be published in Prized Writing 2009-2010, for sale in the UCD Bookstore. One year after book publication, entries will be published on the web at [<http://prizedwriting.ucdavis.edu/past>]
- Publication rights remain with the authors.

## Submission Guidelines

- Entries must be double-spaced, in a 12-point font, with title and page numbers.
- Each entry must be no more than **15 pages**, including all references, tables, figures, and other graphics.
- **The author's name and course information must NOT appear on the manuscript.**
- An entry form must be stapled on top of each separate entry.
- Submit entries to Pamela Demory, Editor, at 367 Voorhies, OR to Aaron Fai, Assistant Editor, 105 Voorhies. **Check the web for current office hours.**
- Students may submit a total of five (5) entries (although only one winning entry per student will be published).
- Entries may be submitted by students or by their instructors with student consent.

## Judging

- Final judging will take place in June 2010; winners and honorable mention recipients will be announced in early July.

NOON January 22, 2010 (for papers written in Summer and Fall 2009)

NOON April 23, 2010 (for papers written in Winter 2010)

NOON June 11, 2010 (for papers written in Spring 2010)
